Introduction

This document forms the Qualifying Explanatory Statement to demonstrate that Gamesys Group Plc has achieved carbon neutrality for its operational (Scope 1 and 2) emissions for the period commencing 1st January 2020 to 31st December 2020.

Section 1: General information

With no company owned vehicles, our direct environmental impacts are limited to the energy use, refrigerant (air conditioning) use, water use and food/paper waste generated in our offices. Although all are relatively minor, by far the largest and most consequential of these is our energy use, and its contribution to climate change.

Section 3: Declaration of on-going commitment to carbon neutrality

Gamesys Group are committed to maintaining carbon neutrality for scope 1 and 2 emissions in accordance with PAS 2060 for the period commencing 1st January 2021.

Section 4: Carbon footprint breakdown

A breakdown of scope 1 and 2 emissions for 1st Jan 2020 to 31st Dec 2020 are detailed below. This footprint has been third party verified to a limited level of assurance by Carbon Trust Assurance, in accordance with ISO 14064-3. Scope 3 emissions were not measured during the year due to the complexity of calculations, which was compounded by the recency of the uniting of JPJ Group Plc and Gamesys Ltd. Work is now underway to capture scope 3 emissions.

Scope 2: <i>Electricity</i>	407	Emissions are based on supplier electricity bills. Where meter readings at year start/end were not available these have been estimated based on the closest readings/supplier estimates available and on a flat profile basis.
		Emissions arising from electricity use in three offices have been excluded (Bahamas, Toronto and Norwich). These offices are used by a total of 13 employees (0.9% of the workforce) and account for less than 1% of office space.
		The market-based method has been used for reporting. Emissions using this method were greater than for the location-based method. Conversion factors were sourced from the electricity suppliers, and where not available, the Association of Issuing Bodies (AIB) residual mix conversion
		factors were used.

The scheme provides fuel-efficient cookstoves to impoverished families in the Qori Q'oncha region of Peru. These fuel-efficient cook stoves emit less carbon emissions than using an open fire. We chose this offset scheme because of the additional societal benefits, specifically because the cook stoves require less fuel the families have more money to spend on food and other essentials.

Terms of Engagement

Carbon Trust Assurance Limited (CTA) was commissioned by Gamesys Group plc (henceforth "Gamesys") to provide an independent, limited level of assurance on the following Selected Information:

- Scope 1 emissions refrigerant gases
- Scope 2 (location-based) emissions purchased electricity
- Scope 2 (market-based) emissions purchased electricity

The Selected Information is presented within Gamesys' carbon footprint calculations spreadsheet. We have not performed any work, and do not express any conclusion, over any other information that may be included in the carbon footprint calculations or on Gamesys' website for the current year or for the previous periods unless otherwise indicated.

Scope

This engagement covers the verification of emissions from anthropogenic sources of greenhouse gases included within the organisation's boundary.

- Organisational boundary: Global operations (11 sites)
- Control approach: Operational control
- Reporting period: 01/01/2020 31/12/2020

Our Conclusion

Based on the work we have undertaken and the evidence provided by Gamesys, nothing has come to our attention that leads us to believe that the Selected Information has not been properly prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the Reporting Criteria.

The total verified footprint was 361 tCO₂e, according to the location-based method and 407 tCO₂e, according to the market-based method. The breakdown by scope is:

- Scope 1: 0 tCO₂e
- Scope 2 (location-based): 361 tCO₂e
- Scope 2 (market-based): 407 tCO₂e

This conclusion shall be read in the context of the remainder of this Assurance Statement, in particular the inherent limitations explained below and this report's intended use.

Reporting Criteria

The Reporting Criteria used by Gamesys Group is the GHG Protocol.

Management Responsibility

The management of Gamesys Group are responsible for:

- designing, implementing and maintaining internal controls relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Selected Information that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error;
- selecting and/or developing objective Reporting Criteria;
- measuring and reporting the Selected Information in accordance with the Reporting Criteria; and
- the contents and statements contained within the Report and the Reporting Criteria.



Our Responsibilities

Our responsibility is to plan and perform our work to obtain limited assurance about whether the Selected Information has been prepared in accordance with the Reporting Criteria and to report to Gamesys in the form of an independent limited assurance conclusion based on the work undertaken and the evidence obtained.

Assurance Standards Applied

We performed our work in accordance with CTA's assurance methodology based on ISO 14064-3:2019.

Our Assurance Activities

Our objective was to assess whether the Selected Information is reported in accordance with the principles of completeness, comparability and accuracy. We planned and performed our work to obtain all the information and explanations that we believe were necessary to provide a basis for our assurance conclusions.

Considering the level of assurance and our assessment of the risk of material misstatement of the Selected Information, whether due to fraud or error, our work included, but was not restricted to:

- assessing the appropriateness of the Reporting Criteria for the Selected Information;
- conducting interviews with Gamesys management to obtain an understanding of the key processes, systems, controls and related documentation in place over the preparation of the Selected Information;
- performing analytical reviews and detailed sampling of the Selected Information; and
- reading the carbon footprint calculations and narrative accompanying the Selected Information in the carbon footprint calculations with regard to the Reporting Criteria, and for consistency with our findings.

Inherent Limitations

The accuracy and completeness of the Selected Information is subject to inherent limitations given their nature and methods for determining, calculating and estimating such data. As such, this Assurance Statement should be read in connection with carbon footprint calculations. For those subject matters with a limited assurance, the evidence-gathering procedures are more limited than with a reasonable assurance, and therefore less assurance is obtained than in an overall reasonable assurance statement.

CTA's Competence and Independence

CTA ensures the selection of appropriately qualified individuals based on their qualifications, training and experience. The outcome of all verification and certification assessments is then internally reviewed by senior management to ensure that the approach is rigorous and transparent.
